### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

Weld-On<sup>®</sup> 505 Key Tite<sup>™</sup> is a low VOC, green pipe thread sealant for metal piping systems:

- Vegetable and mineral oil based formula that lubricates and protects metal pipe threads from rusting and seizing.
- · Non-hardening for easy assembly and disassembly.
- Non-toxic, lead-free and will not affect taste or color of water or any potable liquid in the pipe line.

### APPLICATION:

Weld-On 505 Key Tite is designed for sealing and lubricating metal pipe connections (threaded, flanged, and gasketed). Suitable for use in metal piping systems carrying the following gas and liquids with temperature range from - 50° F to 450° F (-45° C to 232° C): diluted acid, air (compressed or gaseous), alcohols, diluted alkalis, brine, diluted caustics, gases (manufactured or natural), low pressure steam lines, liquid sugar, and hot or cold water. Not recommended for oxygen, fluorine, propane, or liquid sodium systems.

## **DIRECTION:**

Store Weld-On 505 Key Tite below 150° F (65° C).

- 1. Stir before use.
- 2. Ensure threads are clean (free of dirt, oil, moisture, etc.) and made with a good die.
- 3. Apply sealant freely to male threads only.
- Assemble joints. Do not over torque. System may be put in service immediately. Follow the pressure rating as supplied by pipe and gasket manufacturers.

SHELF-LIFE: 2 years in tightly sealed containers.
